

- 4. Also we had prioritized the immediate needs from the list given by "Fr. Bala and Sr. Philomena"

That's what direct messages are for.
- 2. Don't use group to just to send memes, videos, pictures and news, without reading and reacting to the content shared by others. We have created this group only for Alumni & School related discussions and its project related activities. Please stick to the mission statement of Alumni. Irrelevant content does not belong here. The purpose of this group is to establish collective conversations with others, but when you only place content, but never read or interact, the existence of such groups loses their purpose. No one likes monologues.
- It is advised not to share any jobs postings. We have a separate and dedicated group for Job
 Openings. Job Seekers or Job Providers may request admin to join that Group
- 4. Announcement of event of other groups needs approval from Admin before circulation
- 5. Do not advertise any business on this group without approval from Admins.
- 6. No fund raising message to be circulated in group without written permission from committee.
- 7. Never send content, information or "news" that HASN'T been verified. Placing content whose authenticity has not been definitively proven can be VERY dangerous and harm many people. Whatsapp is infested with many of these things and it's better to put a stop to them than to be guilty of spreading them.
- 8. If you feel uncomfortable in a group for any reason, feel free to leave or "mute" the notifications. It's better to be criticized for leaving than for always complaining. Don't be offended if others leave. Not everyone wants the same information. Do politely excuse yourself before you leave a group.
- 9. Before sending a complaint to a group, identify the "administrator" and share your thoughts with him.
- Don't get angry if someone doesn't respond to your messages in a group. No one is obliged to do so.

Constitution of St. Aloysius Alumni Association Sarvagnanagar, Cox Town, Bangalore 560005

- **1. NAME:** This Association will be known as "St. Aloysius Alumni Association" (SAAA).
- **2. Definition:** The term 'Association' means the association of old students of St. Aloysius Institutions "St. Aloysius Alumni Association." (SAAA.)
- 3. A brief history of St Aloysius Institutions.
 - St. Aloysius Institutions started in the year 1889 with the establishment of the Primary School, owned and managed by the Archdiocese of Bangalore, under Archdiocesan Board of Education. The School has grown and spread its branches to High School, Pre University College, Pre University Evening College, Degree College, Post Graduate Centre in Cox Town, Bangalore.
 - St. Aloysius Institutions was established in response to the need for providing affordable and accessible education for all, especially minorities and socio-economically disadvantaged students seeking to pursue higher education. Inclusive and secular in its approach, St. Aloysius Institutions are committed to provide quality education for all.

The motto of St.Aloysius Institutions is "Let Your Light Shine Forth" which emphasizes our commitment to prepare citizens for others. Enabling and empowering students to be independent.

4. VISION:

"St. Aloysius Institutions provide students with a transformative educational experience to become responsible and committed citizens in the service of the nation."

5. OBJECTIVES:

The objectives of St. Aloysius Alumni Association are as follows:-

- To collaborate with the Management and staff to organize guest lectures, innovative methods of teaching learning and equip the Institution with latest information & communication (ICT) tools for professional Competition.
- Co ordinate with the management and staff in the following activities:
- In providing accessible and affordable education for all with the policy of preferential option for the poor. In sponsoring the students fees, books, uniform examination fees.
- In providing the students training for skills for the prospective career and professional confidence.
- In providing placement for students and have a follow up with the junior Alumni.
- In promoting cultural, sports, value based programs for students.
- In keeping the flag of the Institutions flying high to promote admissions & give publicity.
- In fostering the spirit of service to society and the nation.
- In initiating and supporting various fund raising projects that is in keeping with the objectives of the Association in response to the signs of the times and in the spirit of St Aloysius.
- In granting or sponsoring prizes, scholarship to the institutions in reaching out to the poor and the needy students.
- In procuring: (facilitate co-curricular activities) like Sports, recreational facilities, equipments, provide facilities for social activities between its members and students of the institutions.
- In receiving grants, donations or gifts from benevolent SAAAS members or any other lawful source- always in the name of the Association.
- Any other purpose to be determined at the Annual General Body Meetings.

6. MEMBERSHIP:

- A. The membership will consist of the following categories of members:
 - a) Lifetime Membership
 - b) Annual Membership
 - c) Honorary Membership

Note: Honorary Members will have no rights in any committees in the SAAA, However their Valuable advice would be taken into consideration at all times and discussed in the AGM's, general body meetings and other committee meetings. Core Committee members would take a final call on such topics under discussion.

- B. All persons who are former students of the institutions and have studied in St.Aloysius institutions for a period of not less than two full academic year shall be eligible. However former students who have left the Institutions without even completing one academic year shall not be eligible for becoming members of SAAA.
- C. All persons who are Annual Members may become Life Members upon payment of a one-time Life Membership fee, the amount of which shall be decided by the General Body Meeting Members. All Annual members may convert to Life Membership at any time upon payment of one time Life Membership fee.

7. APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP AND PAYMENT OF MEMBERSHIP/ SUBSCRIPTION FEES:

- a) An applicant for membership must submit his/her particulars to the Secretary.
- b) The Executive Committee will decide on the application for membership. A copy of the Constitution shall be furnished to every lifetime member. Copy of which shall be given only upon payment of the membership fee.
- c) The membership fees, are payable within two weeks of approval to membership. Annual subscription fees shall be payable on or before the end of June of every year.

d) Subscription Fees:

1) Annual Membership :Rs. 300/-2) Lifetime Membership :Rs. 2000/-

(Note:-The above membership fees may be changed once in 3 years.)

e) Lifetime Membership collected to be put into FD in the bank periodically and only the interest gained with that should be used for Association purpose.

- f) Any member who is in default of payment of any subscription fees shall not be qualified to be an office bearer of the Association or a member of the Executive Committee, shall not be entitled to vote or move any resolutions or any other rights or privileges enjoyed by the Annual and Lifetime members.
- g) Any additional funds required for special purposes may only be raised from members with the consent of the General Body of members and approved by the Chief Executive Committee.

8. RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF MEMBERS

- a) Lifetime and Annual members shall be eligible to participate in the activities organized by the Association. The Executive Committee may invite Honorary Members to participate in the activities organized by the Association.
- b) Students who studied in St. Aloysius Institutions for a period not less than two year shall qualify to be office bearers of the Association or members of the Executive Committee.
- c) All members must strictly observe the rules and regulations of the Association or the decisions of the Executive Committee and General Body. Members shall pay all dues of the Association laid in this Constitution. Certain Activities organized by the Association will require participating members to pay reasonable fees or charges which shall be prescribed by the Executive Committee.

9. CESSATION OF MEMBERS

- a) Any member who has acted in a manner contrary to the interest and good of the Association or has any civil offences, may be subject to lose his/her membership.
- b) A member who wishes to resign from the membership must submit it/in writing to the Executive Committee.
- c) Membership and subscription fees, and any other money deposited in the name of the Association are not refundable in the case of cessation of membership.

10. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The executive committee will consist of Ex Officio members and also elected or nominated members however the elected or nominated members should be minimum of eight and maximum of 10 in number.

- a) **Chief Patron** Who is Archbishop of Archdiocese of Bengaluru, who will be invited to chair the meeting of the Association once in a year and look into the smooth functioning of association by providing valuable suggestion. The managers of the Institutions representatives of the Chief Patron will provide his/her service and look into the smooth functioning of the Association.
- b) **The Principal/Head Master** each institution under St. Aloysius Institution is the Ex-officio members of the Association.
- c)The President of the Alumni.
- d)A Vice President
- e)A Secretary
- f)A Joint Secretary
- h)A Treasurer

g)Executive Committee Members will be elected at the Annual General Body Meeting at the completion of two years. An extraordinary Annual General body will be convened at the discretion of the Executive committee for the election of the vacant posts the office bearers.

• Co-opted Members will comprise of 10 or more.

d) The Executive Committee is:

- Responsible for the effective functioning & discipline among the office bearers.
- To examine the application for Membership and approve them.
- To deprive any member of the privilege of membership as per this Constitution.
- Responsible for General welfare, smooth functioning and the integrity of the Association.
- To lay down General policy for the Association
- It always functions in collaboration with the Local Managements of the
- It shall plan a programme of its activities in accordance with the polices Institution and submit the programme to the Management of the Institutions.

11. DUTIES OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEMBERS:

I. The Manger/ Principal/Head Master are - Ex Officio member.

- a) Shall preside at the Annual General Body Meeting.
- b) Shall supervise the general welfare of the Association.
- c) Has the right to call for a meeting of the Executive Committee or the General Body of the Association.
- d) Will provide space for conducting all meetings within the InstitutionS premises.
- e) Works in tune with the spirit and dispositions of the pioneering spirit of St. Aloysius Institutions, Community building, person-oriented and service-oriented relationships

II. The President.

- a) Will prepare the Agenda ahead of time, preside and moderate its meetings so as to ensure its efficient and effective functioning.
- b) Will bring to the notice of the Executive Body certain important issues that pertains to the welfare of the Institution in line with the constitution.
- c) Shall meet and inform the Manger/ Principal/Head Masters about its deliberations.
- d) Brings unique enrichment to the Body by his/her proactive, positive approach at all times. Equips oneself with inner potential, qualities to blossom and let others blossom; enrich oneself to enrich others and vice versa; senses the need for deeper reflection, search/study and organizes an input session, talk/conference as befits the need.
- e) Brings in one's unique contribution of one's inner potential that enlivens and adds enrichment to all spreading an environment of growth and joy in all encounters
- f) Cooperates and coordinates with the Manger/Principal in organizing and carrying out the role entrusted by the Executive Committee.
- g) Shall represent the Association in its dealings with the Governing Body or with outside persons.

III. Vice President

She/he will assist the President in all the above duties and will also take over the President's duties in her/his absence.

IV. Secretary

There shall be one Secretary who shall be elected by the General Body from among the members. The Secretary shall maintain the minutes of meetings and maintain communication with all members. All the correspondences of the Association shall be made by the Secretary. The Secretary will report the activities of the Association at the General Body Meeting. All notices of Meetings shall be sent by the Secretary.

V. Joint Secretary

She/he will assist the Secretary in all the above duties and will also take over the Secretary's duties in her/his absence.

VI. Treasurer

The Treasurer shall be elected by the General Body. The Treasurer shall receive all subscriptions and shall acknowledge receipts thereof. All sums received by the Treasurer shall be deposited in the Bank account standing in the name of the Association. The Treasurer shall present an Audited Statement of Account of all money received and expended by the Association and Balance Sheet drawn up to 31st March of the financial year. The audit of the association will be done by the auditor of the Institutions.

12. Operation Of Bank Account

- a) Operation of Bank account: Signatories shall be the Principal/Manager and President/Treasurer of the Association.
- b) Principal/Manager or President/Treasurer will be allowed for withdrawal of amount below Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only)

c) All withdrawals above Rs. 5000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) will necessarily have to be signed by the Principal/Manager along with President/Treasurer after the approval of the executive committee.

13. FUNCTIONSTHE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE:

The Executive Committee shall be empowered to do all acts in their discretion on behalf of the Association save as restricted herein or by any resolution at a Meeting of the General Body. Without prejudice to the generalities of provisions of above, the Executive Committee may -

- Accept subscriptions, donations and contributions
- Manage the affairs of the Association and incur offices expenses.
- Constitute from time to time one or more than one Sub-Committees and delegate any of its power or duties subject to its supervision and control. The President and Secretary shall be ex-officio Members of all the Sub-Committees formed.
- Administer the funds and the property of the Association.
- Prepare an audited statement of the Accounts and Balance Sheet shall be placed before the Annual General Body Meeting.

14. ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING

The Annual General Body Meeting shall be held in October each year, such shall be determined by the Executive Committee and the Principal/Head Master of St.Aloysius institutions. The Annual General Body Meeting shall be convened giving Twenty one (21) days clear notice.

15. SPECIAL GENERAL BODY MEETING

An Extraordinary or Special General Body Meeting may be held at the discretion of the Executive Committee or on the requisition in writing of not less than twenty (20) members.

16. QUORUM

When the meeting of the Executive Committee cannot be held for lack of quorum, the meeting shall stand adjourned to the same day and hour later with not less than 30 members.

At any Executive Committee Meeting, seven (7) elected/nominated members and at least The Manger/Principal or Head Master of the Institutions shall constitute the Quorum, provided that at least two (2) are office bearers.

17. AMENDMENTS

The rules framed herein shall not be altered, amended or abridged in any manner except at a General Body Meeting or an extra ordinary general body meeting called for the said purpose meeting, wherein a resolution to the effect has been passed by not less than two thirds of the members present and voting.


- One notice board should be separately maintained in all S.T. Aloysius (Middle school, High school, PU college and degree college). For the usage of Alumni purpose.



3. Treasurer : Mr.Mark Isdore


4. Secretary : Ms. Manjula


