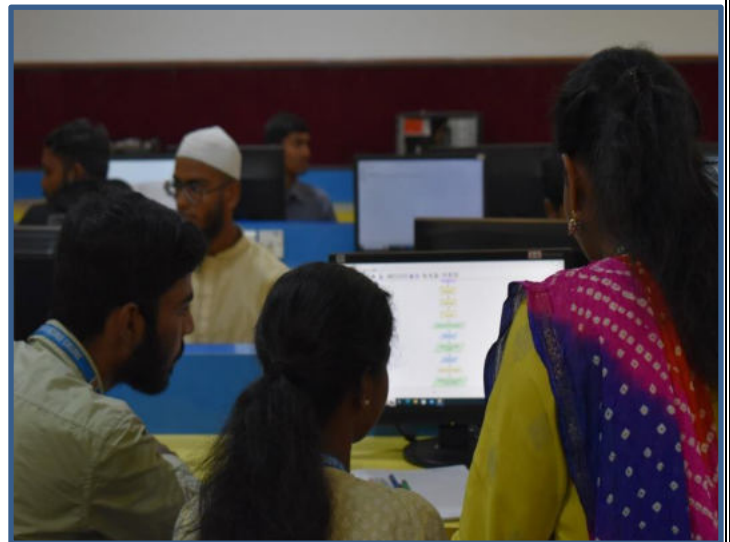
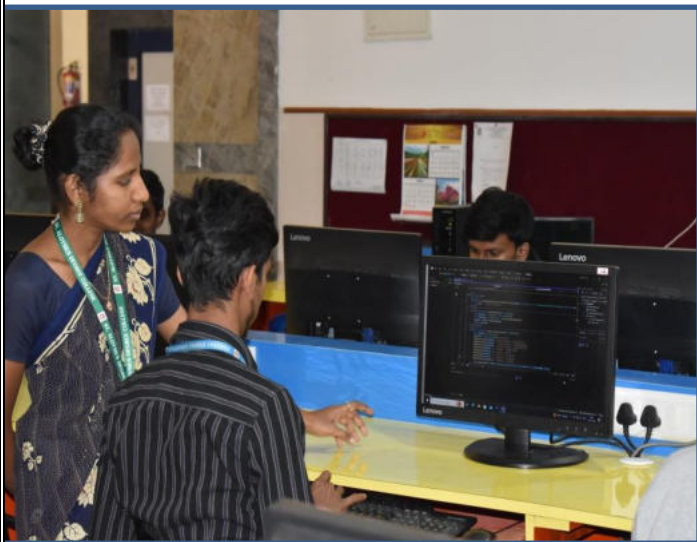
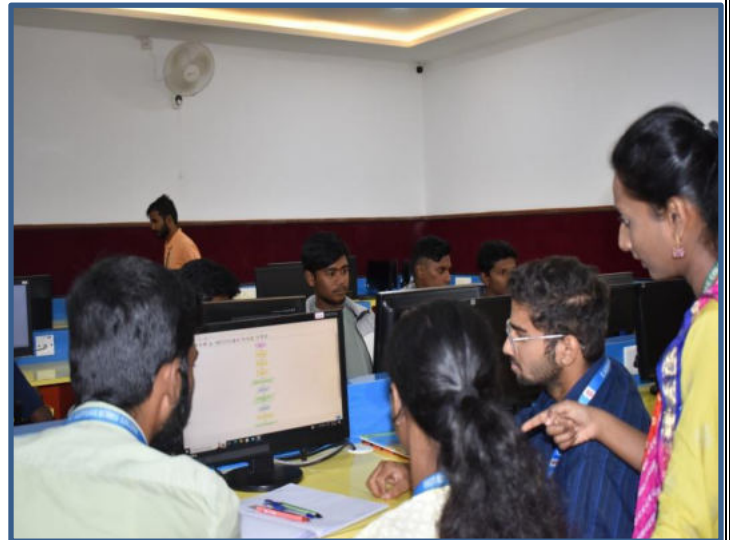

2. Psychology LAB:

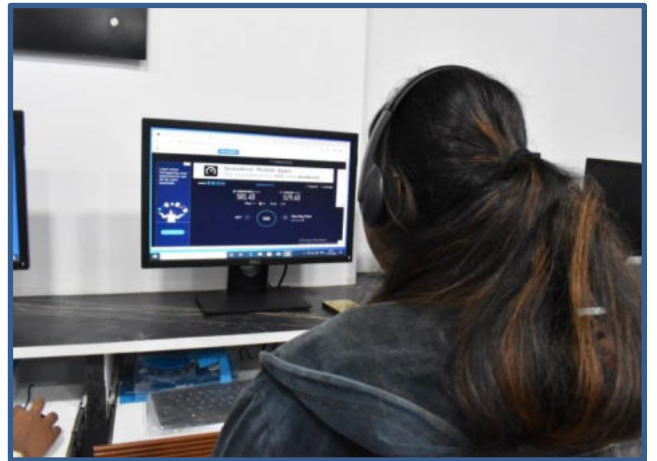

3. Language LAB:

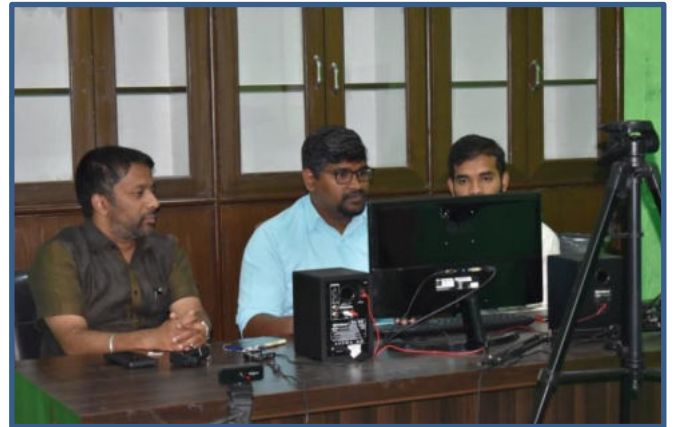
