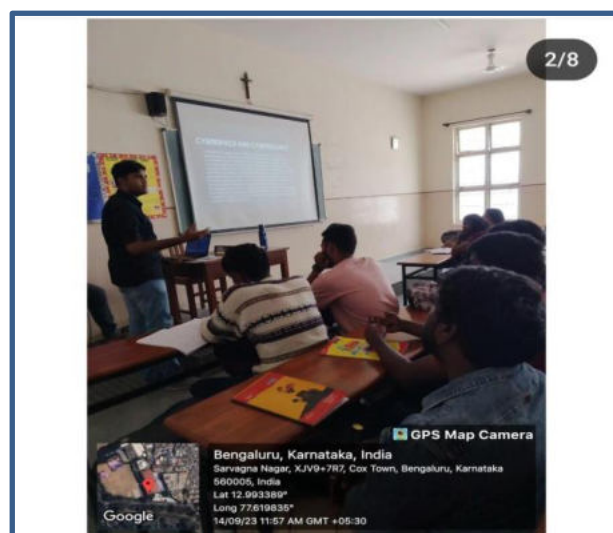
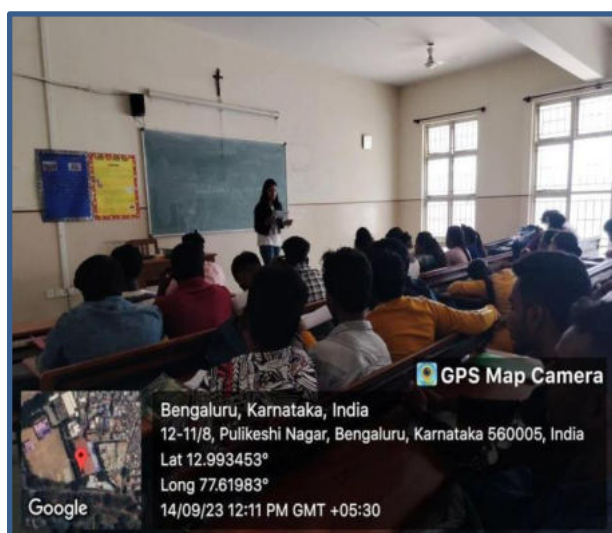
## 2. Bridge Courses:

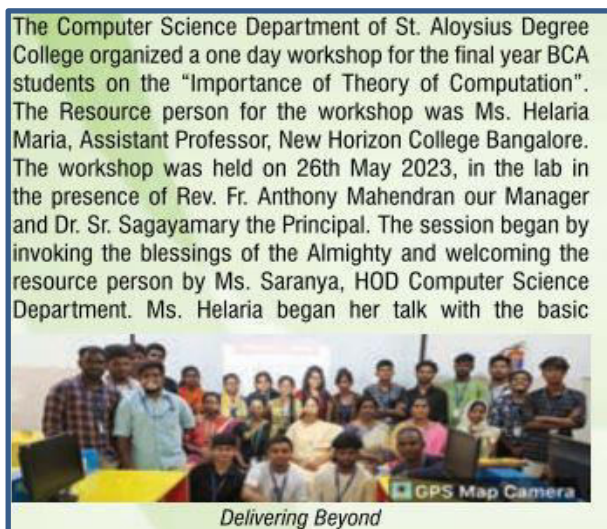
