

This session was conducted by KOTAK Life insurance company.



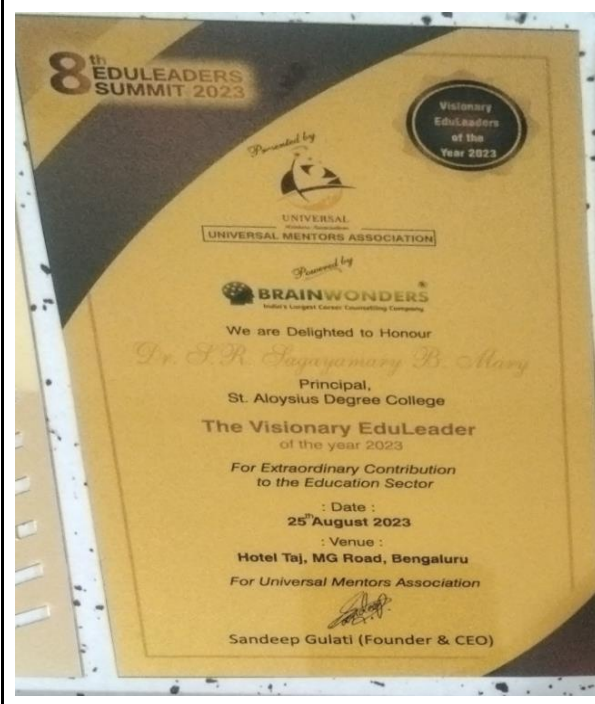
