Public Hearing | 24th June 2023- Aweksha organised a public hearing for survivors to share their journeys of struggle, resistance and resilience. The women narrated harrowing tales of physical torture as well as diverse forms of mental and emotional abuse that they faced in their marriages. The hearing provided a safe space of empathetic and non-judgmental listening. From the stories, it was evident that abusers follow similar patterns, and speak the same language of control and of power. The hearing was attended by Raghavendra Shettigar, Deputy Secretary, Karnataka Legal Services Authority (KSLSA); Geeta Rameseshan, advocate, legal scholar and women's rights activist; and Sangeeta Rege, Director - CEHAT, feminist scholar, counsellor and researcher.
